### USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

- All measurements are to the center of the green, in yards.
- **Please respect the privacy of our homeowners** and do not retrieve golf balls from private property.
- **Remember Golf Karma** — repair ballmarks, rake bunkers and refill all divots with sand provided — and good things will happen.
- Please place all rakes in bunkers.
- Restrooms are located after Hole 5 (Nicklaus II) and after Holes 3 & 7 (Norman).
- Desert Rule – a ball that enters the desert may be treated as if it entered a lateral hazard and proceed according to Rule 26-1. Ball may be dropped two club-lengths from the last point it crossed the turf, no closer to the hole, with a penalty of one stroke.
- Stones in bunkers are considered movable obstructions; proceed under Rule 24-1.
- There is no out-of-bounds on the golf course. The desert rule may be used at all times. Golf balls may not be played from constructed homes and the Desert Rule must be used.
- The fairway bunkers on holes 4 and 5 on the Norman Course eventually transition into waste areas. The vegetated areas should be treated as waste areas and the club may be grounded.
- On the Nicklaus II Course, the large desert area on far left side of Hole 3 is a waste area and the club may be grounded.
- Drop areas are provided on Hole 8 Nicklaus II (red tee) and Hole 6 Norman (red tee.)
